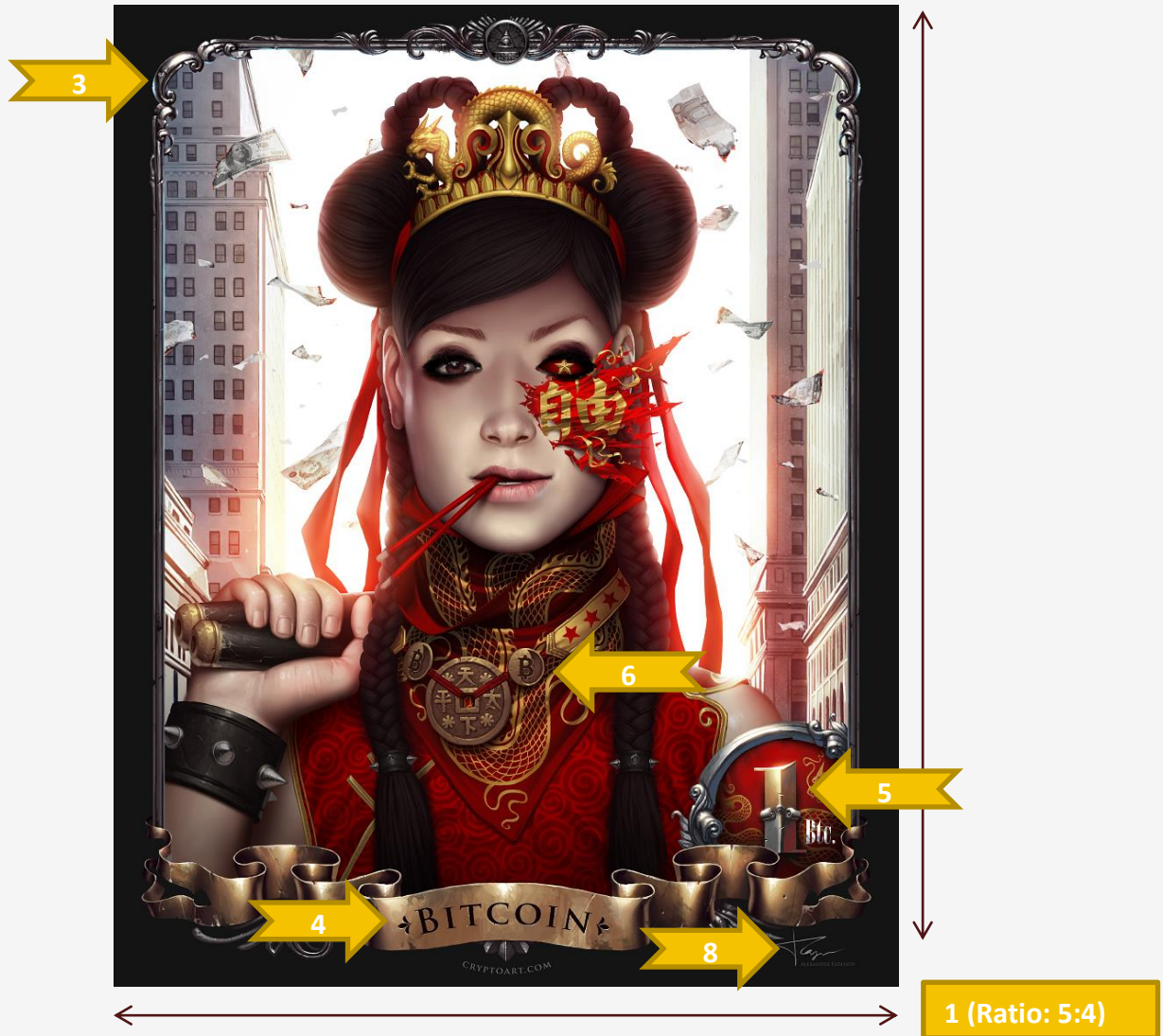


CRYPTOART

Cryptoart Specifications



Submission Guidelines:

1. Size Ratio. Cryptoart is ratio 5:4. We print 3 sizes, the smallest image is 8" x 10", but will measure 8.5" x 11" on paper. See all the [sizes we print](#). Cryptoart can be vertically or horizontally oriented.
2. File Size. We need to print a 20" x 25" image at 300 ppi. That means 6000 pixels x 7500 pixels at 300 dpi. The file size will be around 120 megabytes. Please do not flatten Photoshop images.
3. Add a border around the image. Your border does not need to be this ornate. It should work with your image. If you are commissioned to do a series, use the same for each image. Outside the border should be a solid color. It does not need to be black as the example above. Use the same color for the series.
4. Cryptocurrency name. We may ask that your Cryptoart be for a currency other than Bitcoin.
5. A currency denomination amount. Place this in the lower right side. This is the suggested amount of cryptocurrency to store. We will provide this to you before you begin. Again, your border and currency amount do not need to look like the example above.
6. Each currency has a symbol. Add the currency symbol to the picture at least once.
7. Hide our logo in the image somewhere (not shown). It can be small, large, any color, transparent, etc. [Download the .png version here](#). [Download the vector here](#).
8. Place your digital signature on the image. It does not need to be below the border as in this version.
